	Family Grief, anticipatory related to deterioration of resident's condition	Family will verbalize emotions &/or conflicts related to illness and loss.		Assess family for signs of anxiety Encourage family to express concerns, fears. Determine family's present knowledge. Provide information regarding change in resident's condition. Involve family as active team members in discussions, information sharing, & decision making as able. Involve family in resident's care (ie. oral care, grooming, repositioning, skin care). Review with family how cultural values, beliefs and practices can be incorporated into resident's care. Encourage discussions regarding powers of attorney, wills and financial resources as appropriate.	
				Provide information regarding supports such as social worker, spiritual care advisor, community services as appropriate.
